#### A WSP PROJECT

SafiSan Projects are won, implemented and operated by licensed Water Service Providers (WSPs)

#### SANITATION

By implementing SafiSan Projects WSPs and Counties can greatly improve the sanitation and public health situation within their area

#### PRO-POOR

SafiSan Projects are targeting the underserved urban poor

#### AREA FOCUS

SafiSan Projects target specific underserved urban areas

#### SANITATION VALUE CHAIN

To avoid public health risks SafiSan Projects consider the entire sanitation value chain; toilets, emptying, transport and treatment

#### BETTER TOILETS

- -SafiSan projects provide subsidies to households and landlords that build toilets according to SafiSan specifications
- -KSh 20,000 for a new toilet and KSh 15,000 for a rehabilitated toilet
- -SafiSan Projects promote Urine Diverting Dry Toilets (UDDTs) and flush toilets

#### SANITATION TEAMS

SafiSan Projects train Sanitation Teams that can empty toilets and transport the dry content from (UDDTs) to Decentralised Treatment Facilities (DTFs)

#### SANIGO

The WSTF has developed a special (NEMA certified) cart that can be used for the safe transport of the content of UDDTs

#### SOCIAL MARKETING

SafiSan Projects provide funding for Social Animators (sanitation marketers) who do the social marketing of the SafiSan toilets and services

#### TREATMENT

SafiSan projects also includes funding for the construction of Decentralised Treatment Facilities (DTFs)

#### PUBLIC HEALTH

The Public Health Officer (PHO) is a key member of the Project Task Team of a SafiSan Project

#### INCENTIVES FOR WSP

WASREB allows WSPs to include all costs (human resources, materials) in the tariff proposal
